DESCRIPTION

The laboratory of Spencer LaVere Smith (<http://sllslab.org/>) at UCSB is a neuroscience and neuroengineering laboratory. We develop new technology for neuroscience research, and we apply those tools in our own experiments to study how the brain works during behavior at the circuit level, across multiple regions of the brain, with cellular and synaptic resolution.

We are actively seeking a Lab Manager.

As the Lab Manager, you will report directly to Prof. Smith, and will help support the smooth operation of the laboratory. Activities will include experiments, training personnel, ordering and administrative support, recordkeeping, helping to maintain regulatory compliance, assisting with grant and paper preparations, organizing lab resources, and generally coordinating smooth operation of the laboratory.

Qualified candidates will have an undergraduate degree and some experience with research. Experience with molecular biology and especially genotyping is required. Some mouse handling is required for this position.
